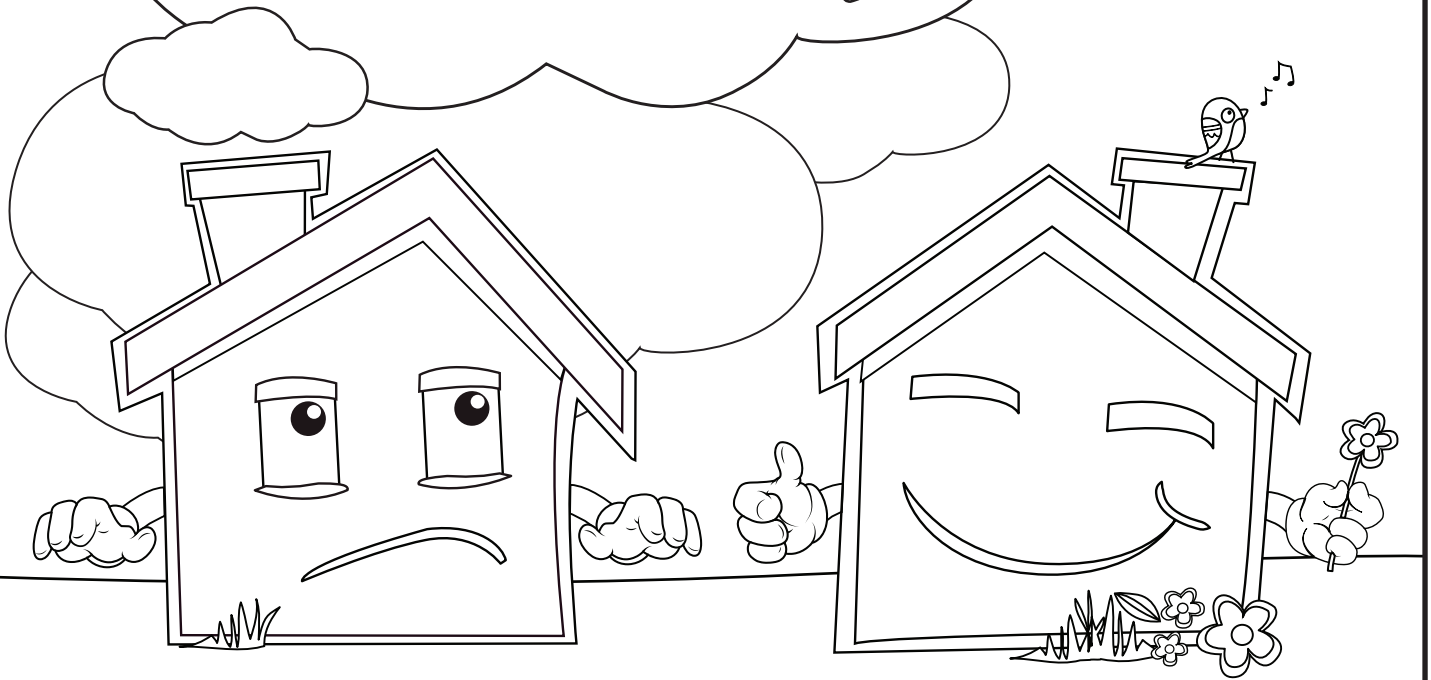
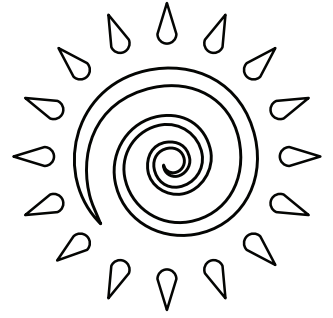

If your wood heater is smoking, it might not be operating as efficiently as possible. Tips:

 Use only small logs of seasoned, untreated wood

 Use several small logs rather than one large log

 Store wood under cover in a dry, ventilated area

 Maintain a bright flame, never let your heater smoulder
